He earned great wealth due to hard work and polite behavior. He purchased shares in companies. Later he also took in hand the trade of jute and became known as the Jute King. He was a strong believer in God. He spent a lot of money in social welfare works. He started many hostels, libraries and dharamshalas. He floated scholarships for financially weak and needy students. He financed higher studies of Sir Chhotu Ram. He was known as Bhamasah of kshatriya caste. The British government awarded him the title of 'Sir'.

## ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

University is named after great environmentalist, Guru Jambheshwar Ji Maharaj. Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology started its journey on 20th October, 1995 at Hisar, Haryana. The University was established under the Act of State Legislature that facilitates excellence in teaching and research in promising areas of higher education with focus on new frontiers of Science & Technology, Engineering Studies, Environmental Studies, Media Studies, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Management Studies, Yoga Science, Physiotherapy, Humanities and Social Sciences and also to achieve excellence in these related fields. ## ABOUT COURSES

### LL.M. (2 YEAR DEGREE COURSE)

The LL.M. 2Years course is of 2year duration with 4 semester examination system.

#### Seats Intake

LL.M. (2 Year Degree Course) - 50 Seats

#### Eligibility Criteria

A person who has passed LLB 3 years Programmes or B.A. LL.B. 5 years programme or an Equivalent programme duly recognized a UGC-Approved University with at least 50% marks (45% marks for SC/ST) aggregate, shall be eligible to join LL.M. Course.

### LL.B. 3 YEAR (PROFESSIONAL) COURSE

The LL.B. (Professional) course is of three year duration with 6 semesters examination system.

#### Seats Intake

LL.B. (Professional) - 3 Year Course - Two Sections of 60 Students in Each Section

#### Eligibility Criteria

Bachelor's Degree or Master's Degree Examination of the GJUS&T or any Examination recognised as equivalent thereto, with English as one of the subjects in the qualifying examination and with atleast 45% marks in the aggregate 40% for SC/ST candidates (as per Bar Council of India requirements) in either of these Degree (One-Year Degree/Diploma Courses like, D.P.Ed., M.Ed., B.Ed., B.Lib. Sc., etc. shall not be considered as equivalent to Bachelor's Degree).

### B.A. LL.B. 5 YEAR INTEGRATED COURSE

B.A.LL.B. 5 year integrated course is of 5 years duration with 10 semesters examination system.

#### Seats Intake

B.A.LL.B. - 5 Year Course - Two Sections of 60 Students in Each Section

#### Eligibility Criteria

- A candidate who has passed Senior Secondary Certificate Examination (10+2 standard) from The Board of School Education Haryana or an Examination recognized as equivalent thereto, with 45% marks in the aggregate with five subjects **including the subject of English** shall be eligible to seek admission in the first semester of B.A.LL.B (Hons.) 5 - Year Integrated Course.  
Explanation :- The candidate who have obtained 10+2 through Open University System directly without having any basic qualification i.e., Matric/Secondary/10+2 are not eligible for admission in the B.A.LL.B. (Hons.) 5-Year Integrated Course.
- The minimum eligibility condition in the case of SC/ST Candidates shall be 40% marks in the qualifying Examination with **English as one of the subjects**. (There shall be no rounding of percentage of marks of the qualifying Examination i.e.40% and 45% means exact percentage. Thus 39.5% and above does not mean 40% and 44.5% above does not mean 45%).
- All Courses are open only to whole time students and not to employed or self-employed.

**Note : CANDIDATES HAVING COMPARTMENT/RE-APPEAR, IN THE QUALIFYING EXAMINATION SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED ADMISSION TO ANY OF THE COURSE EVEN PROVISIONALLY.**

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

### Admission Procedure

The Admission in B.A.LL.B. (5 Year), LL.B. (3 Year) & LL.M. shall be made on the basis of Merit of Qualifying Examinations as per rules & other terms and conditions of the GJUS&T, Hisar. Candidates have to apply online application form for admission in B.A.LL.B. 5 years course, LL.B 3 years course and LL.M. 2 years course on the college website i.e. [www.crlawcollege.com](http://www.crlawcollege.com)

### Reservation, Distribution of Seats for B.A. LL.B. 5 Year Course, LL.B. 3 Year Course & LL.M. 2 Years Course

For the Purpose of Reservation of Caste (SC, BC, DAP, EWS & Ex. Service Man and their dependents) the list mentioned by GJUS&T and latest reservation policy of Govt. of Haryana to be notified by Haryana Govt. from time to time.

### It is further stated that :

The Scheduled Caste students of Haryana whose family income from all sources is upto Rs. 2.5 lacs per annum as prescribed by the State Govt. for Post Matric Scholarship and who produces, at the time of admission, the "Caste" and "income" certificates issued by the competent authority, are not required to pay Fees/Fund and they may pay a sum of Rs. 2000- (Refundable) as security/caution money at the time of admission. The eligible SC students will apply the Post Matric Scholarship Form on the concerned Portal. The fee will be deposited from her/his scholarship amount as and when they receive the scholarship in their account through DBT. In case the student does not apply for scholarship or is found ineligible for award of scholarship or being eligible she/he is not awarded scholarship due to one or the other reason and not deposited fee she/he will be liable to pay full fee, along with late fee @ Rs. 10/- per day.

Proof of Original Migration Certificate be uploaded if the candidate has passed his/her 10<sup>th</sup>, 10+2, B.A, M.A. or any other examination, other than from GJUS&T.
3. Nothing contained in this Online prospectus would be construed to convey sanction or cited as an authority for which University Regulations in Calendar Vol. I, II and the relevant Rules in Vol. III, alone are applicable.

If the concerned authorities are not satisfied with the character, past behaviour and antecedents of a candidate, they may refuse to admit him/her to law course in order to ensure academic standards, discipline and peaceful atmosphere in the College. The Vice-Chancellor may cancel the admission of any student on the recommendation of the Principal/Director of the College.

**Note :** Fee once paid shall not be refunded in any case.

## WEIGHTAGE

Admissions to the B.A. LL.B., LL.B., LL.M. Programmes will be made on the basis of the academic merit of the qualifying examinations plus weightage(s) of Sports and NSS, if any, subject to fulfilling the other conditions mentioned in the College Prospectus for the session 2026-27:

1. If two or more candidates secure identical total score in academic merit plus weightage(s) of Sports and NSS, if any, for admission to regular postgraduate programme(s), where admission is based on academic merit of the qualifying examination, the candidate older in age will be preferred.
2. For admission to undergraduate and integrated programme(s), the marks obtained in the aggregate of best 5 subjects (including the subject of admission/eligibility) of the qualifying examination i.e. 10+2 will be considered to decide the academic merit of the qualifying examination. If two or more candidates have secured identical marks in the best 5 subjects (including the subject of admission/eligibility) in 10+2 plus weightage(s) of Sports and NSS, if any, the candidate older in age will be preferred.

(IX) No weightage(s) of Sports and NSS shall be given once the merit list is finalized. It is found that a candidate has knowingly or willfully concealed or suppressed or misrepresented any information/ fact which renders her/him ineligible to take admission to department of the University, and the admission, if granted, shall stand cancelled and fees deposited by her/him will be forfeited. She/he shall have no claim whatsoever against the College concerned and the case, if necessary, shall also be reported to the police against her/him.

### 5.5 Additional weightage(s) of Sports and NSS

(1) Sports Weightage:

Special weightage up to 5 marks will be given to Sports persons. The candidates claiming their "Sports weightage" having Sports Gradation Certificate as Grade A, Grade B, Grade C and Grade D in accordance with Notification dated 15th November, 2018 of the Haryana Government, Sports & Youth Affairs Department will be given the sports weightage as under:-

## NSS Weightage:

The Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. Haryana, Higher Education Department, Chandigarh conveyed the direction/instruction vide letter memo no. 15/1-2020 NSS (2) Dated, Panchkula: 10.05.2023 that the State Government has decided that the additional 5 marks weightage is to be awarded to NSS Merit Certificate holder volunteers students of 10+2 class during the admission process of Undergraduate Courses/ Classes from the Academic Session 2023-24 and the same may be considered for Undergraduate level NSS Merit Certificate holders students from the next Academic Session i.e. 2024-25 for admission process of Postgraduate Courses/Classes. Accordingly, the weightages of NSS is also approved for the postgraduate programmes from the academic session 2026-27

I) No weightage(s) of Sports and NSS will be given unless appropriate claim along with certificate(s) are uploaded on the while submitting online application form. The certificate of weightage(s) of Sports and NSS issued by the competent authority after the last date for submission of online application form will not be considered and no weightage will be given for finalization of merit for admission to Undergraduate Programmes. The College will display tentative score (marks) of weightage(s) of Sports and NSS on College website [www.crlawcollege.com](http://www.crlawcollege.com) for inviting objections, if any.

(ii) If any candidate finds any discrepancy in the weightage(s) of Sports and NSS, then she/he can submit her/his objections through registered e-mail on the e-mail ID: [crlawcollege5@gmail.com](mailto:crlawcollege5@gmail.com) as per Schedule of Key-Dates, otherwise the displayed tentative score of weightage(s) of Sports and NSS will be treated as final for the purpose of counseling(s). However, the weightage(s) of Sports and NSS claimed, while submitting objections through e-mail, as per Key-Dates (2026-27), if found genuine, then it will be considered for preparing merit list.

## CERTIFICATES

### CHARACTER CERTIFICATE

Character Certificate is essential and Admission Forms, NOT accompanied by Original Character Certificate shall not be accepted. The details of character certificate to be furnished shall be as under :

- (a) Private Candidates : Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as private candidates should submit their **Character Certificate duly signed by a First Class Magistrate/Notary Public.**
- (b) Gap in Study : Male candidates who have gaps in their academic career after the Qualifying Examination, must furnish a **gap certificate in the form of affidavit** or certificate from the employer and should also furnish separately Character Certificate of gap period from a First Class Magistrate/Notary Public.
- (c) Regular students : Candidates who have passed the qualifying examination as regular students **of session 2025-26** must submit the **Original Character Certificate from the Head of the Institution** last attended as per specimen attached.

### Other Certificates

At the time of seeking admission and applying online, following documents are required to be submitted:-

- (a) Certificate of Last Public Examination passed.

- (h) Self attested copy of Residence Certificate in the case of candidates claiming to be bona fide residents of Haryana, if applicable.
- (i) Four recent passport size coloured photographs.
- (j) Self attested copy of Differently Abled Person Certificate.
- (k) **Parivar Pehchan Patra (Family ID).** (l) **Income Certificate.** (J) **APPAR ID**



Candidates selected for admission will be required to pay their full fee and other charges at the time of admission and if any candidate failed to do so his/her seat will be offered to the next candidate.

**IMPORTANT NOTES:**

1. Admission form received (either complete or incomplete) after the last date and specified time (as the case may be) for the purpose shall not be considered under any circumstances.
2. If the last date for receipt of admission forms falls on a holiday or that day is declared holiday by the University, the next working day will be considered as the last date for the purpose.
3. No individual intimation will be sent to the candidates for admission purposes. All candidates must find out their merit position in the Merit list displayed on the Notice Board of the Chhaju Ram Law College, Hisar on the prescribed date & time and website of college.
4. The candidates seeking admission for a particular category must be present in the Chhaju Ram Law College, Hisar according to schedule. The admissions will be made on the spot and dues will be accepted at the same time. Therefore, the candidates must bring with them the dues to be paid by them.
5. The candidates must bring with them their all original documents on the date of admission.
6. All entries in this form must be made by the candidate.
7. The Application Form must be completed in all respect. No column should be left unfilled. If any information sought is not applicable to the Candidate, the words "N.A." should be entered against that column.
8. A number of documents like copies of University/Board certificates, photographs, certificates claiming special status, etc. need to be uploaded with application. Without the required documents being attached, the application is liable to be rejected as incomplete.
9. All copies of University / Board Certificates, Photographs and character certificate etc., must be attested by the Head of the Institution last attended or by a Class-I Gazetted Officer or by an Officer of the University not below the rank of Assistant Registrar /Notary Public. The full name of the attesting Officer and the official seal must be clearly legible on the certificate.
10. A candidate appearing in the counselling cannot claim admission if found ineligible on verification of documents/certificates at stage of admission or at a later stage.
11. If the admission authorities are not satisfied with the character, past behaviour and antecedents of a candidate, he/she may be refused admission to LL.B./B.A.LL.B./LL.M. course in order to safeguard academic standards and ensure discipline and peaceful atmosphere in the college, The Principal on the recommendation of admission committee may cancel the admission of any student.
12. A student of B.A.LL.B./LL.B.(Professional)/LL.M. course shall not be allowed to take admission simultaneously in any other course.
13. It shall be the responsibility of the candidates to remain in touch with the college and to ascertain the progress of admissions. They should not wait/ depend on receipt of communication from the college.
14. If a student is absent from the classes continuously for five days without intimating to the Chairperson/Incharge of the Department, her/his name shall be removed from the Department's roll. However, she/he may be allowed re-admission by the Chairperson on payment of fee of Rs. 1500/- taking into consideration the possibility of fulfilling the requirement of attendance to be eligible to appear in the end semester examinations. For the students detained for entire semester/session, the prescribed full fee of semester/session will be charged in addition to re-admission fees.

Instructions regarding Bona fide Residents of Haryana issued vide letter No. 62/17/95-6 GSI Dated 3rd October, 1996, No. 62/32/2000-6GSI dated 23<sup>rd</sup> May, 2003 and No. 62/27/2003-6GSI dated 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2003 by the Chief Secretary to Government Haryana.

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**Subject: Bonafide residents of Haryana - Guidelines regarding.**

I am directed to invite your attention to Haryana Govt. letters noted in the margin on the subject noted above vide which the instructions were issued regarding simplification of procedure for obtaining the certificate of Domicile for the purpose of admission to educational institution (including technical/medical institution). The matter has been reconsidered in the light of judgment delivered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the case of Dr. Pradeep Jain vs. Union of India and others reported as AIR 1984-SC-1421, wherein it has been held that instead of the word 'Domicile' the word 'Resident' be used in the instructions issued by the State Government and it has been decided to revise the Government instructions. Henceforth, the following categories of persons would be eligible for the grant of Resident Certificate: -

1.

- i) Candidates, who have passed the examination qualifying there for selection in an institution from a school/college in Haryana.
- ii) Children / Wards (if parents are not living) / Dependents of the: -
  - (a) employees of Haryana State posted in or outside Haryana State or working on deputation;
  - (b) employees of the statutory bodies/corporations established by or under an act of the State of Haryana who are posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana or outside Haryana.
  - (c) employees of the Government of India posted in Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of the Haryana Government;
- iii) Children/wards (if parents not living)/dependents of persons who after retirement have permanently settled in Haryana and draw their pensions from the treasuries situated in the State of Haryana.
- iv) Children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of pensioners of Haryana Government irrespective of the fact that the original home of the retiree is in a state other than Haryana or he has settled after retirement in or outside Haryana;
- v) Children/Wards (if parents are not living)/dependents of persons, who have permanent home in Haryana and include persons who have been residing in Haryana for a period of not less than 15 years or who have permanent home in Haryana but on account of their occupation they are living outside Haryana;
- vi) The wives of such persons who are bona fide residents of Haryana irrespective of the fact that they had belonged to any other State before marriage;
- vii) Persons who were born in Haryana and produce a certificate to that effect; provided that the parents/guardians (if parents are not living) of persons belonging to any one of the above-mentioned categories are:
  - a) Citizen of India;
  - b) Produce an affidavit to the effect that they or their children/wards (if parents are not living)/dependents have not obtained the benefit of Resident in any other State.
- viii) Children & Wards of the accredited journalists residing at Chandigarh and recognized by Govt. of Haryana.

2. All candidates claiming to be bona fide residents of Haryana should produce a Haryana Resident Certificate signed by the District Magistrate/General Assistant to Deputy Commissioner or Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil) of the District/Sub-Divisions to which the candidates belong. Resident Certificates in respect of elsewhere or in respect of the Children/Wards/Dependents of Haryana Govt. employees who are posted at Chandigarh, Delhi or elsewhere or in respect of Children /Wards/ Dependents of pensioners of Haryana Govt. or in respect of the Children/Wards/Dependents of the employees of the Government of India posted at Chandigarh or in Haryana in connection with the affairs of Haryana Government, or in respect of Children/Wards/Dependents of the employees and retirees of the Statutory Bodies/Corporations of Haryana established by or under an Act of the State of Haryana or a Central Act and located at Chandigarh, Haryana or outside Haryana, should be by their respective Heads of Departments.
  3. Candidates seeking admission in educational institutions (including medical and technical institutions) located in Haryana, may not be required to produce Resident Certificate, if they have passed the examinations from a school/college situated in Haryana. For this purpose, a certificate of the Principal/Headmaster from concerned institution, where the children/wards studied last should be considered sufficient. The Principal/Headmaster of the institution shall be competent to issue such certificate, which should be sufficient.
  4. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of claim that he belongs to the State of Haryana but at any subsequent time is discovered that his claim was false, the student shall be removed from the institution, all fees and other dues paid up to the date of such removal shall be confiscated. The Principal/Headmaster may take such other action against the student and her/his parents/guardians as he may deem proper in the circumstances of any particular case.
